7. Class representative should be







11. There should be a regular watch by the anti-harassment committee to check any type of harassment incidences.
12. The grievances redressal committee should be in effect to redress the grievances, if any.
13. There should be toilets for the physically disabled students

14. The college should have chairs for the left handers.
15. The college library should issue books to the students as per their genuine demand.



ACTIONS TAKEN


1. Internal Quality Assurance Plan was made.


10. A regular watch is kept to check the smoking, use and sale of drugs, tobacco and tobacco products on the college premises.

15. The college library issues books to the students as per their genuine demand.



Meeting of the I R A C









1. The actions were taken as per the suggestions of the I R A C given in the last meeting.
