

Meeting of the IBAC

Today, on 03.8.2021 a meeting of the College Internal Quality Assurance Cell was held at 3.00 PM in the Principal's office of the College. In the meeting the following decisions were taken by all the members of the cell unanimously:

1. The academic programmes carried out online by the college during COVID-19 as per the instructions of the affiliating University, Directorate of Higher Education and Uttarakhand Government following the Govt.'s SOPs was appreciated by the IBAC. Classes of the different programmes during COVID-19 were run online according to the college time table by the faculty members. Study materials also were supplied online to the students.

2. Keeping in view the spread of COVID-19, online admission to different programmes should be done as per the instructions of the affiliating Univ. and the Uttarakhand Govt. Classes should be run online and offline in both modes as per the instructions of the

affiliating University under the SOPs of the Government. Study materials also should be supplied to the students through Online mode.

3. Different Committees formed in the college should stick to their respective duties
4. Faculty members should contribute to the designing of the curriculum as per the requirements of the affiliating University.
5. Faculty members and mentors should pay special attention towards the advanced learners and slow learners.
6. Merit scholarship and Samaj Kalyan scholarship should be well processed on time.
7. Academic calendar should be prepared and followed.
8. Choice based Credit systems and elective courses as per the affiliating University, Curriculum should be implemented.
9. While admission to different programmes offered by the college, reservation to different vertical and horizontal categories should be given as per the Uttarakhand Govt.'s Rule.

10. All the students, faculty members and non-teaching staff should use masks, sanitizers and maintain social distancing and will get their thermal scanning at the gates before their entry in view of COVID-19.

11. Instructions for using masks, sanitizers and maintaining social distancing should be displayed at the gates. All the visitors also will get their thermal scanning at the gate.

12. All the students of the College must come in the prescribed dress of the College and must keep their I-cards with them and show to the members of the Praetorial Board of the College on demand while visit.

13. Seats arrangement in the classes will be done maintaining the distance following SOPs of the Govt.
